

ORDINANCE NO. 1191

(9 of 1980)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA OPENING THOSE STREETS IN THE PLAN KNOWN AS "DONORA PLACE PLAN" AND DEDICATING SAME TO THE PUBLIC USE.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Donora had incorporated within its municipal boundaries that section of the Township of Carroll known as "Donora Place Plan" as laid out by the Monongahela Land Company:

WHEREAS, this Plan had been made a matter of record in the Recorder of Deeds Office of Washington County in Plan Book Volume 2 at Pages 158 and 159:

WHEREAS, this section of the Borough has been the site of residential construction and that these sites for new construction have been and shall be in need of public streets:

WHEREAS, it appears that the streets appearing of record in the Plan known as "Donora Place Plan" have not been opened within the meaning of the Borough Code nor been dedicated to the public use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: That those streets which appear in the recorded Plan known as "Donora Place Plan" are hereby opened and dedicated to the public use. Furthermore, by the terms of this Ordinance, the Borough formally accepts the streets as laid out in this Plan.

SECTION TWO: That Council shall, at its option and based on all relevant considerations, improve the streets opened and dedicated by the terms of this Ordinance. To this effect, Council shall direct the Borough Engineer to set the grade on these streets and to supervise the improvements so authorized by Council.

SECTION THREE: That the terms of this Ordinance shall not affect actions taken by previous Councils regarding the vacation of streets or portions thereof in "Donora Place Plan" or the actual or constructive abandonment of certain streets or portions thereof.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall become effective on the thirtieth day after its enactment.
