

ORDINANCE NO. 1194-A

(4 of 1981)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NUMBERED 1182 and 920 BY MODIFICATION OF THE AMOUNT OF FINES IMPOSED FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

I. That Section Three of Ordinance 1182 entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 1140A AND 1053 PROVIDING FOR GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION AND FEES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF, is hereby amended to read as follows: "Any person, whether as principal, agent or employee, violating or assisting in the violation of this Ordinance and/or its Amending Ordinances shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction before the District Justice shall pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00 plus the costs of prosecution. In default of payment of said fines and costs, the offender shall be sentenced to the Washington County Jail for a term not to exceed 10 days."

II. That Section Three of Ordinance 920 entitled AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS, CUSTODIANS AND KEEPERS OF LICENSED DOGS FROM ALLOWING SUCH DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE; PROVIDING FOR THE SEIZURE AND IMPOUNDING OF SUCH DOGS WHEN AT LARGE; REQUIRING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CHARGES INCURRED BY REASON OF SUCH DETENTION OF DOGS; and PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION is hereby amended to read as follows: "Any owner, custodian or keeper of any dog who shall violate the provisions of the first section of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and on conviction before the District Justice shall pay a fine of \$100.00 plus the costs of prosecution. In default of payment of such fine and costs, the offender shall be sentenced to a term of incarceration in the Washington County Jail not to exceed five (5) days. Provided, however, that such fine and costs shall be in addition to any payments required to be made under the second section of this Ordinance."
