

ORDINANCE 1198

(3 of 1982)

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF MULLIN STREET AS SAME LIES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA.

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: That that portion of Mullin Street which lies between the easterly line of Fayette Avenue and the easterly line of Elk Alley is hereby vacated and abandoned absolutely.

SECTION TWO: That the portion of Mullin Street so vacated by the terms of this Ordinance is 100 linear feet.

SECTION THREE: That this vacation is based upon a Petition filed by the County of Washington seeking such vacation, notice being given to all concerned parties, a public hearing held on July 8, 1982 with evidence presented and a finding by Council that such vacation would be in the best interests of the Borough.
