

ORDINANCE NO. 1210

(8 of 1983)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1984

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, under authority given it by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in Section 1302 and other Sections of the Borough Code:

SECTION I: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the Borough of Donora subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1984 as follows:

Tax rate for General Borough Purposes, the sum of thirty five (35) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for Interest and Sinking Fund Charges on the indebtedness of the Borough, the sum of eighteen and three quarters (18³/₄) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for Pensions and Retirement for Borough employees, the sum of one-half (1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for Lighting and Illuminating Streets, Highways and other Public Places, the sum of eight (8) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for Recreation Purposes, the sum of one-quarter (1/4) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for Fire Fighting Equipment and Fire Protection, the sum of one and one-half (1 1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Tax rate for the Purpose of Supporting Ambulance and Rescue Squads servicing the Borough, the sum of one-half (1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

THEREBY making a total tax rate for all Borough Purposes of sixty (64 1/2) four and one-half mills.

SECTION II: That any Ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
