

ORDINANCE NO. 1216

(6 of 1984)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 555 and 963 WHICH ESTABLISH A FIRE DEPARTMENT AND PRESCRIBE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THAT AGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Section 2 of Ordinance 963 as stated is hereby amended to read as follows:

The membership of the Department shall be composed of the Fire Chief, one or more salaried truck drivers, firemen and auxiliary firemen as Council shall so authorize and appoint, which such appointments shall be subject to applicable civil service requirements.

Any person, male or female, eighteen years of age or older, may apply for membership in the Donora Fire Company Auxiliary and if elected to membership and approved by Council, shall be an Auxiliary Fireman of the Borough of Donora.

At such time that the Fire Chief determines that such Auxiliary Fireman has met the requirements and training for a Fireman, he shall make his recommendation to the Public Safety Committee of Borough Council.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
