

ORDINANCE NO. 1219

(2 of 1985)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: No person, firm or corporation shall park or cause to be parked any prohibited motor vehicle in the residential districts of this Municipality.

SECTION TWO: For purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

A. Motor Vehicle: any self-propelled device upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon an opened or unopened street.

B. Prohibited Motor Vehicles: motor vehicles, as defined above, including but not limited to the following:

- 1) Truck tractors, single or double axle, designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn.
- 2) Trailers designed to be towed by another motor vehicle.
- 3) Any vehicular combination of (1) and (2).
- 4) Tank trucks.
- 5) Box type trailers in excess of 20 feet in length.

C. Parking: the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

D. Residential Districts: those sections of the Borough designated as R-1B, R-1C, R-2 and R-3 in Ordinance 1034; these

definitions as set forth in Ordinance 1034 are incorporated by reference into the terms of this Ordinance as if the same were set forth in their entirety.

SECTION THREE: Any person, firm and/or corporation that is found guilty of violating the terms of this Ordinance, after hearing before the District Justice, shall be fined no less than \$100 together with the costs of prosecution.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall have immediate effect.
