

ORDINANCE NO. 1233

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES ON BOROUGH STREETS.

Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any person to park either a truck tractor or trailer or any combination thereof on streets in either residential or community business sections of this Borough.

SECTION TWO: For purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

1. "Motor Vehicle" shall mean a device which is self-propelled and in, on or by which any person or property may be transported.
2. "Park" shall mean the halting of a motor vehicle whether occupied or not, except momentarily or for the limited purpose of loading or unloading persons or property.
3. "Trailer" shall mean a vehicle designed to be towed by a motor vehicle.
4. "Truck Tractor" A motor vehicle designed and used for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn.
5. "Streets" shall be defined by Section 1701 of the Borough Code.

6. "Residential Sections" shall be those areas of the Borough of Donora designated residential and community business sections ^{" AS SO DESIGNATED BY "} by the Zoning Ordinance of the Borough.

7. "Combination" Two or more vehicles physically interconnected.

SECTION THREE: For purposes of this Ordinance Section 1701 of the Borough Code and those applicable sections of the Zoning Ordinance of the Borough of Donora are hereby incorporated by reference as if the same were set forth in their entirety.

SECTION FOUR: Any person who violates the terms of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Summary Offense and subject to a fine of \$ 300.00 and the costs of prosecution.
