

ORDINANCE NUMBER 124

THOMPSON AVENUE GRADE--FIRST STREET AND BRADFORD

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Thompson avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, between First Street and Bradford Alley.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Thompson Avenue, in said borough, between First Street and Bradford Alley, is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:

West Curb Line,--Beginning at the North line of Bradford Alley at an elevation of 857.49 feet, and rising at the rate of 2.689 per cent for a distance of 99.84 feet to an elevation of 860.17 feet; thence rising at the rate of 5.2 per cent for a distance of 40 feet to an elevation of 862.25 feet; thence falling at the rate of 2.5 per cent for a distance of 10 feet to an elevation of 862 feet, at the south curb line of First Street.

East Curb Line,--Beginning at the North line of Bradford Alley, at an elevation of 856.5 feet, and rising at the rate of 2.689 per cent for a distance of 139.44 feet to an elevation of 860.25 feet; thence falling at the rate of 2.5 per cent for a distance of 10 feet to an elevation of 860 feet, at the South curb line of First Street.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance this 21st day of March, A. D. 1904.
