

ORDINANCE NO. 1246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA VACATING
TWO ALLEYS AS THE SAME APPEAR ON THE BOROUGH STREET PLAN

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora,
Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

ONE: That pursuant to § 1741 of the Borough Code, as amended, the
following alleys are hereby vacated:

I. Dewey Alley as the same lies between St. Nicholas
Drive and Frederic Street.

II. An unnamed alley, fifteen (15) feet wide, as the
same is situate in the northern portion of the Borough lying
between property now or formerly owned by Paul J. Sasko and
Rita E. Sasko, his wife, and bounded on the East by a right-of-way
of Consolidated Rail Corporation and on the West by Meldon Avenue.

TWO: That this Ordinance shall have full force and effect after
the procedure established by § 1741 of the Borough Code has been complied
with as to the vacation of Borough Streets.


THREE: That the vacation of item II, supra, is under and subject
to a right-of-way of the Borough of Donora for any and all sewer
lines/connections with the express reserved right to enter on said unnamed
alley for the purpose of constructing, rebuilding and maintaining said sewer
lines and/or connections.
