

ORDINANCE NO. 1253

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AND OTHER MUNICIPALITIES WITHIN THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON PROVIDING FOR INTERMUNICIPAL POLICE CO-OPERATION BY GRANTING AUTHORITY TO OFFICERS OF EACH MUNICIPALITY TO OFFICIALLY ACT AS POLICE OFFICERS IN OTHER MUNICIPALITIES WHEN PERFORMING DUTIES IN THE OTHER MUNICIPALITIES AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENTS OF EACH MUNICIPALITY TO RENDER AID AND ASSISTANCE TO ONE ANOTHER.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Council of the Borough of Donora, and the same is enacted and ordained, by and with the authority of the same:

Section 1. The Borough of Donora shall enter into agreements for intergovernmental cooperation known as the "MUNICIPAL POLICE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT," and the "MUNICIPAL DRUG TASK FORCE AGREEMENT", the exact details of which are incorporated herein made a part hereof and attached as Exhibits "A" and "B".

Section 2. The duration of these Agreements shall be indefinite, subject to termination by any municipality as provided in the Agreements.

Section 3. The purposes and objectives of these Agreements are as follows:

(a) to enhance the co-ordination of drug investigations in the Washington County area; and,

(b) to provide for mutual police aid across jurisdictional lines to enable police to more effectively enforce the provisions of narcotics and illegal drug laws and thereby to preserve the safety and welfare of the entire area; and,

(c) to have available for use throughout the territorial limits of all municipalities signing the mutual agreement, the services of police employed by any and all of the municipalities under the conditions set forth and in compliance with the Municipal Police Jurisdiction Act, 42 Pa.C.S.A. §8953.

Section 4. The parties executing these Agreements hereby agree to be bound and to adhere to the terms and conditions as outlined therein, which terms include the manner and extent of financing the Agreements, the organizational structure necessary to implement the Agreements, the powers and scope of the authority delegated in the Agreements, and the manner in which property, real or personal, shall be acquired, managed or disposed of.

Section 6. This action is taken pursuant to the authority granted the Borough of Donora by the Intergovernmental Co-operation Act, 1972, July 12, No. 180 §1, et. seq., 53 P.S. §481 et. seq., as amended.
