

ORDINANCE NO. 1260

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1091 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1184-A RELATING TO PALMER PARK AND AMENDING AND ADOPTING THE PALMER PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section I, Paragraph 1 of Ordinance No. 1091 and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1184-A and the Palmer Park Rules and Regulations pertaining to park hours are amended to read as follows: "The Park shall be open daily to the public only from the first Sunday of April until the last Sunday of October between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and dusk. At dusk, all activities in the park shall cease and all persons in the park shall leave. No person, other than authorized employees of the Borough, shall be in the park at any time between dusk and 8 o'clock A.M. on the following morning except for organized athletic or recreational groups which may use the park at other times after first obtaining a permit from the Borough Secretary."

SECTION TWO: Section Two of Ordinance No. 1091 and Section Three of Ordinance No. 1184-A are amended to read as stated in the Palmer Park Rules and Regulations: "Any person who shall violate any of the rules and regulations contained in this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof, before a Magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, Full Restitution, and costs of prosecution for each and every offense or to undergo imprisonment for not more than Ten (10) days."

SECTION THREE: The camping section of the Palmer Park Rules and Regulations is amended to read as follows: "No camping shall be permitted in the park."

SECTION FOUR: The pavilions in the park shall be available for public use on a first come first serve basis. No pavilion may be used without first obtaining a permit authorizing the use of said pavilion. Individuals and/or groups may obtain permits for use of the pavilions from the Borough Secretary. Borough Council shall from time to time establish rental rates for the use of these pavilions as well as assessing a required non-refundable deposit to be paid at the time of applying for said permit.

SECTION FIVE: The Palmer Park Rules and Regulations as previously advertised by publication on July 31, 1991, and August 1, 1991, are hereby ordained and enacted in full subject to the amendments as stated in this ordinance.
