

ORDINANCE NO. 1270

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR LITTER CONTROL.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Council of the Borough of Donora in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the Authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION II: LITTERING PROHIBITED

A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation or any agent thereof to place, throw, store, accumulate or maintain, or cause to be placed, thrown, stored, accumulated or maintained any used cans, papers, paper boxes, used lumber, rubbish, debris, animal matter, garbage, empty bottles or other containers upon any property within the Borough of Donora or on or near any alley, highway or stream located in said Borough.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to spit saliva, expectorations, tobacco or other substances, upon the sidewalks or footways in any of the highways, streets, lanes or alleys within the Borough of Donora.

SECTION III - PENALTIES

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be

sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$300.00) together with costs of prosecution, or to undergo imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION IV - SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any provision or part of this ordinance is adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not effect the validity of this ordinance or chapter as a whole or any part or provision not adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.
