

ORDINANCE NO. 1275

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1268 PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN FIRE INSURANCE PROCEEDS SHALL BE PAID TO THE BOROUGH FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL CHARGES RELATING TO THE INSURED PROPERTY, PROVIDING THAT IN CERTAIN FIRE LOSSES A PORTION OF THE INSURANCE PROCEEDS SHALL BE HELD BY THE BOROUGH AS SECURITY AGAINST THE TOTAL COST OF REMOVING, REPAIRING, OR SECURING THE DAMAGED BUILDING, PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR ADMINISTRATION, AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION I: This Ordinance is intended to comply with Act of July 9, 1992, P.L. 678 No. 98, Section 1 as amended.

SECTION II: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1268 is amended to designate the Borough Manager as the officer who is authorized to carry out all responsibilities and duties stated in said Ordinance.

SECTION III: Section II of Ordinance No. 1268 is amended to state that the insuring agent shall transfer from the insurance proceeds to the designated officer of the municipality in the aggregate of \$2,000.00 for each \$15,000.00 of a claim and for each fraction of that amount of a claim, this Section to be applied such that if a claim is \$15,000.00 or less the amount transferred to the municipality shall be \$2,000.00.

SECTION IV: All other provisions of Ordinance No. 1268 shall remain in full force and effect.
