

ORDINANCE NO. 1281

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1274 REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS, BUSINESSES, AND CORPORATIONS TO OBTAIN A BUILDING PERMIT FOR ANY CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BUILDING PERMITS; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT WITHIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO FLOODING; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR ANY PERSONS WHO FAIL, OR REFUSE TO COMPLY WITH, THE REQUIREMENTS OR PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED and ordained by the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: That Section 2.09 fees shall be amended as follows: Application for a building permit shall be accompanied by a fee, payable to the municipality based upon the estimated cost of the proposed construction as determined by the Building Permit Officer at the following rates:

Estimated Cost	Fee
\$ 0.00 to \$ 200.00	\$0.00
\$ 201.00 and up (new construction and improvements)	\$5.00/\$1,000.00

SECTION II: All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1274 as stated in the original Ordinance shall remain in full effect.
