

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1291

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1202 REQUIRING PERMITS FOR THE OPERATION OF RESTAURANTS, PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR SUCH PERMITS, AND PROVIDING FOR INSPECTIONS, REPORTS AND EXAMINATIONS BY THE HEALTH OFFICER.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania; and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION I: That SECTION FOUR of Ordinance Number 1202 be amended as follows: Inspections, Reports and Examinations: The Health Officer shall make annual inspections of every restaurant within the Borough of Donora. If at such inspection, the Health Officer discovers the violation of any item of sanitation required, he shall make a second inspection after the lapse of such time as he deems necessary for the defect to be remedied. The second inspection shall be used in determining compliance with the requirements of this Ordinance. Any violation of the same item of this Ordinance at such second inspection shall call for immediate suspension of permit.

One copy of the inspection report shall be posted by the Health Officer on an inside wall of the restaurant. This report shall not be defaced or removed by any Person except the Health Officer.

The Person operating the restaurant shall on request of the Health Officer permit access to all parts of the establishment and shall permit copying of records of food purchased.

SECTION II. That SECTION FIVE of Ordinance Number 1202 be eliminated in its entirety, including the attachment.


SECTION III. That SECTION SIX of Ordinance Number 1202 be eliminated in its entirety.

SECTION IV. That Ordinance Number 1202 be amended to adopt the 1995 recommendations of the United States Public Health Service/Food and Drug Administration, as amended.

SECTION V. All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1202 as stated in the original Ordinance shall remain in full effect.
