

ORDINANCE NO. 1302

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1256 OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, TITLED MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania; and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that Borough of Donora Municipal Solid Waste Ordinance No. 1256 be amended as follows:

SECTION I. SECTION III: PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES shall be amended to include the following addition:

"7. No resident shall be permitted to begin to leave Municipal Waste out for collection any earlier than 5:00 o'clock, p.m., of the evening before the regularly scheduled Municipal Waste collection day."

SECTION II. SECTION V: STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR COLLECTION shall be amended to include the following addition:

"4. No Municipal Collector and Waste Hauler shall be permitted to begin Municipal Waste collection or transportation any earlier than 5:00 o'clock, a.m.."

SECTION III. SECTION IX: PENALTIES shall be amended as follows:

"Any person, whether as principal, agent or employee, violating or assisting in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a Summary offense which is


punishable by a fine or not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$300.00. After Notice, each day's neglect to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance or any such regulation shall be deemed a separate offense and be subject in all respects to the same penalty as the first offense, and separate proceedings may be instituted and separate penalties imposed for each such day's offense after the first conviction."


SECTION IV. Any Ordinance or parts of any Ordinance in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this amending Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION V. All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1256 not inconsistent with the terms and conditions set forth in this amending Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


