

ORDINANCE NO. 1315

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1269 OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR OWNERSHIP OF DOGS, CATS AND OTHER DOMESTICATED AND NON-DOMESTICATED ANIMALS.


BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that SECTION III of Borough of Donora Ordinance No. 1269 establishing regulations for ownership of dogs, cats and other domesticated and non-domesticated animals be amended to include the following subsection:


"i. All owners of animals shall carry a scoop and receptacle to remove any animal excrement and/or feces while walking their animals within the Borough of Donora. All owners in the company of their animals within the confines of the Borough of Donora who do not have on their person the required scoop and receptacle shall be deemed in violation of this Ordinance and subject to the penalty provisions therein."

All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1269 not inconsistent with the terms and conditions set forth in this amending Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
