

**ORDINANCE NO. 1321**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1274 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1281 OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTNERSHIPS, BUSINESSES, AND CORPORATIONS TO OBTAIN A BUILDING PERMIT FOR ANY CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BUILDING PERMITS; SETTING FORTH CERTAIN MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT WITHIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO FLOODING; AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR ANY PERSONS WHO FAIL, OR REFUSE TO COMPLY WITH, THE REQUIREMENTS OR PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that SECTION 2.09 of Borough of Donora Ordinance No. 1274 and SECTION I of Borough of Donora Ordinance No. 1281 shall be amended as follows:


"Application for a building permit shall be accompanied by a fee, payable to the municipality based upon the estimated cost of the proposed construction as determined by the Building Permit Officer, which building permit fees shall be established by Ordinance of Donora Borough Council."

All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1274 and Ordinance Number 1281 not inconsistent with the terms and conditions set forth in this amending Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
