

## **ORDINANCE NUMBER 1326**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, TO ORGANIZE AND ESTABLISH AN AUTHORITY UNDER "THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES ACT OF 1945", DESIGNATED AS ACT NO. 164, APPROVED MAY 2, 1945, TOGETHER WITH ALL SUPPLEMENTS THEREOF AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING AND/OR MAINTAINING THE NECESSARY FACILITIES FOR A CIVIC CENTER FOR THE RECREATION AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AND TO APPOINT A BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF SAID CIVIC CENTER; AND ALSO FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXERCISING AND ENJOYING ANY AND ALL OF THE POWERS CONFERRED BY SAID ACT, THE SUPPLEMENTS THEREOF AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Council of the Borough of Donora to organize and establish an Authority for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and/or maintaining the necessary facilities for a Civic Center for the recreation and welfare of the citizens of the Borough of Donora; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Council of the Borough of Donora to appoint a Board of Directors for the management and administration of a Civic Center and also for the purpose of exercising and enjoying any and all of the powers conferred by the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, the supplements thereof and amendments thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania; and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

**SECTION I.** Council of the Borough of Donora shall establish an Authority with the Corporation Bureau of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, its supplements and amendments, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and/or maintaining the necessary facilities for a Civic Center for the recreation and welfare of the citizens of the Borough of Donora and also for the purpose of exercising and enjoying any and all of the powers conferred by the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, the supplements thereof and amendments thereto, and Council of the Borough of Donora shall comply with all rules and regulations of the Corporation Bureau for the incorporation of the said Authority.

**SECTION II.** The name of the Authority shall be Donora Civic Center Authority.

**SECTION III.** The documents necessary to establish the Authority with the Corporation Bureau of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall be executed on behalf of the Borough of Donora by the Mayor, and under its municipal seal, attested by the Borough Administrator, and such officers are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all things necessary and appropriate to effect and establish the Donora Civic Center Authority.

**SECTION IV.** The Council of the Borough of Donora shall appoint a Board of Directors consisting of five (5) members for the management and administration of the Donora Civic Center Authority.

**SECTION V.** The term of office for each member of the Board of Directors shall be five (5) years, with the exception of the initial members of the Board of Directors whose terms shall expire after one (1) year, two (2) years, three (3) years, four (4) years and (5) years, respectively, so that in each succeeding year the term of office of one (1) member of the Board of

Directors shall expire and Council of the Borough shall appoint and/or reappoint one (1) member to the Board each year.

**SECTION VI.** The term of office for each member of the Board of Directors shall begin on January 1<sup>st</sup> following the appointment of the said member by Council of the Borough of Donora.

**SECTION VII.** Any vacancy on the Board of Directors shall be filled by appropriate action of the Council of the Borough of Donora.

**SECTION VIII.** The Board of Directors of Donora Civic Center Authority shall be governed by By-Laws approved by the Council of the Borough of Donora and adopted by the initial Board of Directors and any amendments or additions to the said By-Laws shall be approved by the Council of the Borough of Donora before being adopted by the Board of Directors.

**SECTION IX.** Any Ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
