

ORDINANCE NO. 1327

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1251 AND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1123 OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AND ANY PRIOR OR SUBSEQUENT ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING A PERMIT FEE FOR OCCUPANCY.


BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1251 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1123 shall be amended as follows:

"Section 2. Every owner of real property seeking a permit to allow any person, firm, or corporation to occupy any premises owned by said property owner shall file an application with the Secretary of the Borough of Donora setting forth the occupants or proposed occupants names, location of the premises, the owner's name and address, and the nature of the proposed use of the house, dwelling, structure of any kind, building, appurtenance or vacant realty, and, if for residence purposes, the names and ages of the occupants. Upon completion of the application the Borough Code Enforcement Officer or health inspector is authorized and empowered to inspect the subject premises and, should said premises and application comply with all ordinances of the Borough of Donora, and all other laws, then, and in that event, the aforesaid Secretary shall forthwith issue a permit of occupancy upon payment of a permit fee of \$5.00."

All other provisions of Ordinance Number 1251 and Ordinance No. 1123 and any prior or subsequent Ordinances not inconsistent with the terms and conditions set forth in this amending Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
