

ORDINANCE NUMBER 147

TENTH STREET GRADE BETWEEN THOMPSON AND McKEAN

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Tenth street, between Thompson avenue and McKean avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Tenth street, between McKean avenue and Thompson avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows:

North curb line: Beginning at the West curb line of McKean avenue at an elevation of 798 feet and rising at the rate of 13.85% for a distance of 39.99 feet to an elevation of 803.54 feet; thence rising at the rate of 12% for a distance of 195 feet to an elevation of 826.94 feet; thence rising at the rate of 3.333% for a distance of 30 feet to an elevation of 827.94 feet; thence level for a distance of 10 feet to an elevation of 827.94 feet at a point opposite the West curb line of Thompson avenue.

South curb line: Beginning at the West curb line of McKean avenue, at an elevation of 798.50 feet; thence rising at the rate of 12% for a distance of 237 feet to an elevation of 826.94 feet at the East curb line of Thompson avenue.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.
