

ORDINANCE NUMBER 15  
HAWKERS AND PEDDLERS LICENSE

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO hawkers and peddlers, and fixing the license fees to be paid by them.

Be it ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to hawk or peddle within the corporate limits of the borough of Donora any goods, wares, merchandise, market produce or other article or articles without first having obtained from the borough clerk a license to hawk or peddle such goods, wares, merchandise, market produce or other article or articles; and such license shall be issued by said clerk only after the delivery to him of a certificate from the borough treasurer showing that the full amount of license fee fixed by this ordinance has been paid into the treasury of the borough, and provided that such license shall not be good or in effect until it has been approved and signed by the Burgess.

Section 2. Any person or persons who carry about and sell, or for the purpose of selling, from door to door, and goods, wares, merchandise, article or articles, whether the same be their own or their principal's, is herewith declared to be a peddler, within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section 3. The Burgess shall have authority to, and may summarily revoke any license, which he has approved and signed, in any instance where he learns that the business, either in its nature, or in the manner of conducting it, is not in accordance with the representations made to him in reference thereto when the application was made to him for the approval of such license.

Section 4. Every person or persons desiring a license to hawk or peddle within the limits of the borough of Donora shall pay to the Treasurer of the borough the sum of Five (\$5.00) dollars for each day for which such license is desired. The Treasurer shall issue therefor a certificate setting forth the amount paid him, the date, the purpose for which license is to be issued and the length of time it is to run; which certificate, when delivered to the borough clerk, shall be his authority for issuing said license. Provided that any person wishing a license to hawk or peddle for a period of more than five and less than thirty calendar days shall receive the same upon payment of twenty-five dollars, and costs of prosecution, for each offense, and in default of payment thereof be confined in the borough lock-up for a period not exceeding five days.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
