

ORDINANCE NUMBER 201

ESTABLISHING GRADE OF 11TH STREET, MELDON TO McKEAN.

AN ORDINANCE, fixing and establishing the grade of Eleventh street, between the West curb line of Meldon avenue and the East curb line of McKean avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:-

Section 1---That the grade of Eleventh street, between the West curb line of Meldon avenue and the East curb line of McKean avenue, in said borough be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows:-

NORTH CURB: Beginning at the West curb line of Meldon avenue at an elevation of 773.5 feet, thence rising at the rate of 5.6 per cent for a distance of 233.00 feet to an elevation of 786.55 feet, at the East curb line of McKean avenue.

SOUTH CURB: Beginning at the West curb line of Meldon avenue at an elevation of 773.5 feet, thence rising at the rate of 5.6 per cent for a distance of 234.40 feet to an elevation of 786.63 feet at the East curb line of McKean avenue.
