

ORDINANCE NUMBER 202

ESTABLISHING GRADE OF McKEAN AVENUE, 10TH TO 11TH STREET McKEAN.

AN ORDINANCE, fixing and establishing the grade of McKean avenue, between the North curb line of Tenth street and the South curb line of Eleventh street, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:-

Section 1---That the grade of McKean avenue, between the North curb line of Tenth street and the South curb line of Eleventh street, in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows:-

EAST CURB: Beginning at the North curb line of Tenth street at an elevation of 797.50 feet and falling at the rate of 2.457 per cent for a distance of 442.41 feet to an elevation of 786.63 feet at the South curb line of Eleventh street.

WEST CURB: Beginning at the North curb line of Tenth street at an elevation of 798.00 feet and falling at the rate of 2.457 per cent, for a distance of 415.62 feet to an elevation of 787.79 feet at the South curb line of Eleventh street.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance the 16th day of January, A. D., 1911.
