

ORDINANCE NUMBER 214

VACATING FAIRVIEW STREET IN WEST COLUMBIA

AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a certain part of Fairview Street, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora.

Be it ordained and enacted, by the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the part of Fairview Street, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora, said county and state, lying between low water mark, in the Monongahela river, and East line of Front Street, in said plan, be and the same is hereby vacated as a street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.
