

ORDINANCE NUMBER 216

VACATING DECATURE ALLEY IN WEST COLUMBIA

AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a certain part of Decature ALLEY, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora.

Be it ordained and enacted, by the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the part of Decautre Alley, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora, said county and state, lying between low water mark in Monongahela River and the East line of Front Street in said plan, be and the same is hereby vacated as an alley and thoroughfare.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.
