

ORDINANCE NUMBER 220

VACATING GEARY STREET IN WEST COLUMBIA

AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a certain part of Geary Street, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the part of Geary Street, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora, said county and state, lying between low water mark in the Monongahela River, and the East line of Front Street in said plan, be and the same is hereby vacated as a street and thoroughfare.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts, thereof, in conflict with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed.
