

ORDINANCE NUMBER 296

REESTABLISHING GRADE OF SECOND STREET BETWEEN CARROLL AVENUE AND SCHOOL STREET.

AN ORDINANCE, refixing and re-establishing the grade of Second Street between the West Curb line of Carroll Avenue and the West Curb line of School Street, in The Borough of Donora.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by The Borough of Donora, in Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1---That the grade of Second Street, between the West Curb line of Carrol Avenue and the West Curb line of School Street, in The Borough of Donora, be and the same is hereby refixed and re-established as follows:

NORTH CURB: Beginning at the West Curb line of Carroll Avenue at an elevation of 857.28 feet, thence rising at the rate of 17.78 per cent for a distance of 189.65 feet, to an elevation of 891 feet, at the East Curb line of School Street at the West curb line thereof to an elevation of 894 feet, as established by the original ordinance No. 88.

SOUTH CURB: Beginning at a point opposite the West Curb line of Carroll Avenue, at an elevation of 857,28 feet, thence rising at the rate of 17.78 per cent for a distance of 189.65 feet, to an elevation of 891.00 feet at a point opposite the East curb line of School Street, thence rising at the rate of 12.5 per cent for a distance of 24 feet to an elevation of 894 feet, at a point opposite the West Curb line of School Street which elevation is that established by the original ordinance No. 88.

SECTION 2---That all ordinances of said borough fixing and establishing a grade on said Street, inconsistent with or which do not conform to, the grade of said street, between the said points, as fixed by this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed, in so far only as such ordinances relate to the grade of said Second Street, between the points aforesaid,
