

ORDINANCE NUMBER 322

RELATING TO LAYING OF SIDEWALKS ON SIXTH STREET BETWEEN HILL ST. AND CASTNER AVE.

AN ORDINANCE permitting and Regulating the Laying of Sidewalks On Sixth Street Between Hill Street and Allen Avenue in the Borough of Donora.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1.

That permission be and herby is granted to the several owners of property abutting on Sixth Street between Hill Street and Allen Avenue, to lay or cause to be laid and constructed sidewalks Five (5) feet in width, and to extend for a distance of said Five (5) feet from the curb of said Avenue.

SECTION 2.

That the construction of and specifications for said sidewalks shall be subject to the approval of the Borough Engineer and otherwise as provided by the several ordinances of said Borough of Donora.

SECTION 3.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to alter, amend or effect Ordinance No. 268, or the other several ordinances of said Borough of Donora, except as herein expressly limited and provided.
