

ORDINANCE NUMBER 367

VACATION OF PORTION OF SECOND STREET

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF SECOND STREET, AS HEREIN DESCRIBED, IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA (WEST COLUMBIA ADDITION)

WHEREAS, the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, deem it necessary to vacate a portion of Second Street, hereinafter described, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Town Council of the said Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That all that portion of Second Street, lying between the South line of Fairview Street and the center line of Walnut Street, also all that portion of said Second Street beginning at a point Fifty (50) feet North of the North line of Walnut Street and extending thence to a point Fifty (50) feet north of the north line of Chestnut Street as originally laid out, said point being on the dividing line between Lots Nos 107 and 108, and Lots Nos. 49 and 50, in the aforesaid Borough of Donora, (West Columbia Addition) be and the same hereby is vacated and closed and the title thereto shall vest in the owners of the premises abutting thereon in the manner provided by law.

SECTION II.

The Borough Engineer is hereby directed to note and enter this vacation of said portion of said Second Street on the General Plan of Street and Alleys of said Borough.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
