

ORDINANCE NUMBER 370
VACATION OF FRONT STREET

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF FRONT STREET, AS
HEREIN DESCRIBED, IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA (WEST COLUMBIA ADDITION).

WHEREAS, the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, deem it necessary to vacate a portion of Front Street, hereinafter described, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Town Council of the said Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That all that portion of Front Street, lying between the South line of Walnut Street and the North line of Market Street, in the aforesaid Borough of Donora, (West Columbia by Addition) be and the same hereby is vacated and closed, and the title thereto shall vest in the owners of the premises abutting thereon in the manner provided by law.

SECTION II.

The Borough Engineer is hereby directed to note and enter this vacation of said portion of said Front Street on the General Plan of Streets and Alleys of said Borough.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
