

ORDINANCE NUMBER 376
SALE OF PROPERTY TO JOSEPH TATOE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE TO JOSEPH TATOE OF BOROUGH PROPERTY CONSISTING OF LOT NO. 11, BLOCK NO .16, IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AT THE PRICE HEREIN NAMED.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Donora, is the owner of certain real estate, situate in said Borough, hereinafter described, which is not necessary or useful for public or borough purposes, and,

WHEREAS, Joseph Tatoe of said Borough has offered to purchase the same for the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, which sum is a fair and reasonable price for the same under all of the circumstances, and

WHEREAS, the Burgess and Council of the said The Borough of Donora deem it advantageous and expedient to sell said real estate to said Joseph Tatoe at the said price of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That the proper officers of said The Borough of Donora be and hereby are authorized and directed to convey to Joseph Tatoe, upon payment of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, ALL that certain lot of ground situate in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, known and described as Lot No. 11, in Block No. 16, lying between Second and Third Streets, fronting on Thompson Avenue Thirty (30) feet, and running back One Hundred (100) feet.
