

ORDINANCE NUMBER 378  
LEVYING ANNUAL TAXES OF YEAR 1916

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, BY LEVYING THE ANNUAL TAX FOR THE YEAR 1916, AND SETTING APART AND APPROPRIATING TO CERTAIN ITEMS OF EXPENDITURE, HEREIN ENUMERATED, THE REVENUES DERIVED FROM ALL SOURCES DURING SAID YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That an annual tax of \$58,566.15, being at the rate of 12 mills on the dollar on the valuation for County purposes, be and the same is hereby levied for the year 1916 upon all property, offices, professions and persons within the limits of the Borough of Donora, made taxable by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for County rates and levies.

Of which said tax of \$58,566.15, the sum of \$14,363.00, and being at the rate of 2.94292 mills on the dollar on said valuation, shall be for the sinking fund heretofore created for payment of the principal, interest and state tax on the funded debt of said Borough; and of which said tax, the sum of \$44,203.15, and being at the rate of 9.05708 mills on the dollar on said valuation, shall be for general Borough purposes.

SECTION II.

That said annual tax of \$48,566.15, together with the revenues to be derived to the Borough, during said year of 1916, from all sources other than from said tax levy, and as estimated by the Finance Committee of said Council at \$16,193.48, making a total sum of all revenues of \$74,759.63, be and the same is hereby set apart and appropriated to the several items, of expenditure, and in the amount of each thereof respectfully, as follows, to wit; Sinking fund, \$14,363.00; Highways and Sewers, \$10,000.00; Police, \$9,000.00; Salaries and Commission, \$1,256.00; Board of Health, \$2,000.00; Fire Department, \$2,000.00; Legal, \$1,000.00; Light \$7,200.00; Water, \$2,800.00; Printing and Stationery, \$1,000.00; Engineering, \$1,000.00; Building Supplies, \$500.00; Garbage Furnace, \$1,200.00; Abatement on Taxes, \$2,300.00, and Contingencies, \$19,140.63.
