

ORDINANCE NUMBER 379
REGULATING APPEALS IN RELATION TO ASSESSMENT.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING APPEALS IN RELATION TO THE ASSESSMENT OF TAXES IN
THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of
Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted
by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That the Borough Council does herein constitute itself a Court of Appeal in
relation to the assessment of taxes.

SECTION II.

That the Borough Council does herein designate its Finance Committee of three
members, a committee to hear appeals in relation to the assessment of taxes, which
Committee shall have the power to grant such relief as may to them seem proper.

SECTION III.

This Council, or in the absence of a lawful quorum, the Committee herein
appointed, shall hear any and all appeals in relation to the assessment of taxes
on the first Monday of each and every month in the Council Chambers of the Bor-
ough at 7:30 o'clock, P. M.
