

ORDINANCE NUMBER 400

VACATION OF ALLEY BETWEEN BERTHA AND HELEN AVENUES

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF AN UNNAMED ALLEY, AS HEREIN DESCRIBED, IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA.

WHEREAS, the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, deem it necessary to vacate a portion of an unnamed alley, hereinafter described, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the said Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That all that certain unnamed alley lying between Helen Avenue and Bertha Avenue, and extending from the North line of Pine Street to Walnut Street, in the aforesaid Borough of Donora, be and the same hereby is vacated and closed, and the title thereto shall vest in the owners of the premises abutting thereon in the directed to note and enter this vacation in the manner provided by law.

SECTION II.

The Borough Engineer is hereby directed to note and enter this vacation of said portion of said unnamed alley on the General Plan of Streets and Alleys of said Borough.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an ordinance this 26th day of July, 1916.
