

ORDINANCE NUMBER 402

VACATION OF MARKET STREET BETWEEN HELEN AND MODISETTE AVENUES

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF MARKET STREET, AS HEREIN DESCRIBED,
IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA,

WHEREAS, the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County,
Pennsylvania, deem it necessary to vacate a portion of Market Street, hereinafter
described, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the said Borough of
Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION I.

That all that portion of Market Street from the West line of Modisette Ave-
nue to Helen Avenue, in the aforesaid Borough of Donora, be and the same hereby
is vacated and closed and the title thereto shall vest in the owners of the pre-
mises abutting thereon in the manner provided by law.

SECTION II.

The Borough Engineer is hereby directed to note and enter this vacation of
said portion of said Market Street on the General Plan of Streets and Alleys of
said Borough.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
