

ORDINANCE NUMBER 415

GRADING, CURBING, PAVING OF HELEN AVENUE FROM WALNUT TO CHESTNUT

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the grading, paving and curbing, with brick, stone or other material, of Helen Avenue, from Walnut Street to Chestnut Street, in the Borough of Donora, and providing for the collection of two-thirds of the cost and expense thereof from the owners of real estate abutting thereon by the foot front rule.

WHEREAS, the owners of all the real estate abutting thereon have petitioned for the grading, paving and curbing of that part of Helen Avenue, hereinafter described, now therefore.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That Helen Avenue from Walnut Street to Chestnut Street, be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be graded, curbed and paved with brick, stone or such other material as the Council shall hereafter determine; the said portion of said Avenue shall be graded to conform to the grade or grades thereof as heretofore fixed by the several Ordinances of said Borough and said improvement shall be made according to the plans and specifications as prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Council and all work shall be done under the supervision of said Borough Engineer.

Section 2. The proper officers of the said Borough are hereby authorized and empowered to (after the lowest and best bid or bids therefore shall have been accepted by the Council, in pursuance of public advertisement made) execute a contract or contracts with the party or parties whose bid or bids have been accepted by said Council as aforesaid, to complete the improvement authorized and directed by this Ordinance in strict conformity with the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, so approved as aforesaid, and upon such party or parties giving to said Borough the proper security for said work.

Section 3. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same and collected in the manner provided in the Borough Code and other Acts of Assembly and ordinances of the Borough two-thirds of the cost and expense thereof, from owners of the real estate abutting on the improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front abutting as aforesaid, said assessment to be estimated by the Borough Engineer.

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Ordained and enacted into an ordinance by the Borough of Donora, in a regular meeting of the Council thereof assembled, held this 31st. day of July, 1916.
