

ORDINANCE NUMBER 7
ADOPTION OF THE PLAN OF DONORA

AN ORDINANCE to adopt the plan of lots of The Union Improvement Company denominated as the plan of the Town of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The Union Improvement Company, a corporation, created and existing under the "laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is the owner of a certain tract of land in Carroll Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, which it has plotted and laid out into town lots, streets lanes, roads and alleys, under the name and style of The Town of Donora Plan of lots.

AND, WHEREAS, the purchasers, inhabitants or residents in said Town of Donora having duly presented to the Honorable Judges, in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Washington County, Pennsylvania, a petition praying said Court to incorporate said Town of Donora under the style and title of "The Borough of Donora", and

WHEREAS, Said Honorable Court in pursuance and in conformity with the prayer of said petitioners did on the Eleventh day of February, A. D. 1901, decree such Town of Donora, a municipal corporation under the name, and style of "The Borough of Donora" now therefore.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same. That said plan of lots of Union Improvement Company, denominated as the plan of the Town of Donora, together with all streets, lanes, roads and alleys as therein designated, plotted or laid out be and the same is hereby adopted as the Plan of the Town of the Borough of Donora, and that said Plan of lots shall and is hereby made part of this ordinance and is designated exhibit "A" and that said plan of lots shall be made into book form known as "Plan Book No. 1", of said Borough of Donora, and shall be filed with the secretary among and be part of the records of said Borough of Donora, and shall at all times be open to the inspection of the citizens or other persons having any business therewith; but provided, however, that said plan of the Town of the Borough of Donora, shall at all times be open to the inspection of the citizens or other persons having any business therewith but provided, however, that said plan of the Town of the Borough of Donora, shall at all times be subject to enlargement, correction, alternation or amendment by the proper corporate authorities of said borough of Donora.
