

ORDINANCE NO. 792

AN ORDINANCE establishing the grade of Ravine Alley.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That the grade of Ravine Alley be and the same is hereby established for both North and South curb lines as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the East line of Linden Alley at an elevation of 811.5 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 6.8% for a distance of 125.0 feet to a n elevation of 820.0 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 8.0% for a distance of 125.0 feet to an elevation of 830.0 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 2.14% for a distance of 140.0 feet to an elevation of 833.0 feet at a point on the West line of lots 28 and 45 in block 54.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
